1	Rights of Registered Nurses Handling Hazardous Drugs
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3	WHEREAS:
5	There is significant evidence indicating that hazardous drug handlers are exposed to
6	hazardous drugs in their daily work routine; and
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8	There is over 20 years of documented research showing that this exposure has led to
9 10	compromised health outcomes by nurses who handle these drugs, their fetuses and potentially by their breast-feeding infants as well as by other health care workers and
11	bystanders; and
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13	There are interventions that can mitigate this exposure based on the occupational
14	hierarchy of controls and medical surveillance; and
15	A facility/a averaginational factors such as safety alimenta have been shown to increase
16 17	A facility's organizational factors, such as safety climate, have been shown to increase compliance of health care workers to safety precautions;
18	compliance of ficultificate workers to safety precautions,
19	THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the American Nurses Association will:
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21	Support the right of nurses to practice in organizations that provide medical surveillance
22 23	modeled on the NIOSH recommendations for medical surveillance for hazardous drug handlers; and
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25	Reaffirm efforts that support the right of nurses to practice in health care facilities where
26	hazardous drug safe handling practices modeled on the NIOSH guidelines are in place and
27	are promoted and where resources are provided that allow hazardous drug handlers to
28	comply with the guidelines; and
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30	Reaffirm the adoption of the NIOSH definitions for both antineoplastic agents and
31	hazardous drugs by health care facilities and also that these facilities have a regularly
32	updated list of drugs that are to be considered hazardous; and
