Dear Dr Grant,

I am writing on behalf of the Board of Directors of the International Council of Nurses (ICN) to express our support for the American Nurses Association during the outbreak of the COVID-19 virus.

As the number of confirmed cases continues to rise across the world, we are all concerned about the health and safety of nurses, as well as that of the population at large. ICN has been working closely with the World Health Organization to support the global effort to defeat this virus. You may have seen our recently released <u>statement</u> on the grave situation in Italy where nurses and other healthcare workers lack the sufficient protective equipment to keep them safe. This is a stark warning to other countries around the world to ensure their health workforce is protected – both physically and psychologically.
